- ❖ *The Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation can only be accessed once you have completed the Make Ethical Decisions Clinic. To access the online evaluation, you will go to www.coach.ca and log into the locker.
- ❖ At least one member of bench staff is required to be Standard First Aid Certified.
- ❖ All teams must have a minimum of one qualified female head or assistant coach which must be present for all competitions.
- ❖ As per Ringette Ontario Policy, requirements must have completed by **November 30th** of the current playing year to be an eligible Bench Staff member.
- ❖ Maintenance of Certification - Coaches must maintain their certification through Professional Development and training opportunities over a 5-year cycle. A coach who does not complete the required Professional Development credits by the end date of their maintenance cycle is no longer qualified to be on the bench until credits are obtained.
