



GAMES & TOURNAMENTS

COMPETITIVE STRUCTURE

- 1) In Ontario, Ringette™ is played at the following competitive levels:

Provincial AA	U14, U16, U19, 18+
Provincial A	U14, U16, U19, 18+
Provincial	U12
Regional	U6 – U8, U10, U12, U14, U16, U19
University	18+
Adult	B/BB, C/CC, Development
Provincial AAA	U19

- 2) In order for teams to participate in sanctioned tournaments and at Regional/Provincial Events, they must register at one of the stipulated competitive levels by completing a Team Registration Form (TRF) in the Ringette Ontario registration system.
- 3) All Regional level play (U6-U19) will be under the jurisdiction of the Region along with the Regional Games and Tournaments Coordinator. They shall be responsible for the sanctioning of regional level tournaments and Regional Championships. These events shall adhere to the current Ringette Ontario Sanction Rules.
- There must be a mandatory coaches' meeting prior to the beginning of all regional championships.
 - All 18+ B, BB, C, CC, Development and 35+ B, C, and Development levels are the responsibility of the Adult Development Program. The Adult Development Program shall be responsible for the sanctioning of Adult Regional and Recreation level tournaments and championships.
 - Community Recreation Level is the responsibility of the Local Association.
- 4) All Provincial A and AA level play shall fall under the mandate of the Games and Tournaments Committee. The Committee shall be responsible for sanctioning Provincial level tournaments as well as organizing the Provincial Events. These events shall adhere to current Ringette Ontario Sanction Rules.
- 5) Provincial AAA level play shall fall under the mandate of the Ringette Ontario Technical Director and Athlete Development Committee. These events shall adhere to current Ringette Ontario Sanction Rules.
