



GAMES & TOURNAMENTS

RINGETTE ONTARIO INTERPROVINCIAL PLAY

1.1 OUT OF PROVINCE/COUNTRY TEAMS

- 1.1.1 This policy applies to any teams from out of province/country playing in Ontario in tournament and/or exhibition games.
- 1.1.2 Where a league regularly schedules games (including exhibition games) with teams from another province, the schedule must be submitted to the region and the Ringette Ontario office at the start of the season.
- 1.1.3 Teams from Alberta, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island shall be accepted by the host association under the assumption they are in good standing in their own province. They are approved if the team submits a copy of their properly completed Team Registration Form (TRF) and the appropriate forms from their Province for Out of Province play.
- 1.1.4 Teams from British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Manitoba shall be accepted under the assumption they are in good standing in their own province. They are approved upon providing proof of liability insurance, a copy of their TRF and the appropriate forms from their Province for Out of Province play.
- 1.1.5 Teams from out of country are approved upon providing a roster, copy of medical and travel insurance for all players and bench staff, a copy of their liability insurance to the host and the appropriate forms from their Country for Out of Country play.
- 1.1.6 The host association/team must complete the Interprovincial Play Form thirty (30) days prior to the event or as soon as accepting the team.
- 1.1.7 The Ringette Ontario Tournament Hosts are to inform Ringette Ontario in writing, immediately, of any incidents that occur during their tournament involving an out of province/country team.
- 1.1.8 Ringette Ontario has the right to disqualify any out of province/country team from participating in Ontario.
- 1.1.9 Ringette Ontario Rules must be used in any division of a Sanctioned Event where out of Province/Country teams participate.

1.2 PLAYING OUT OF PROVINCE/COUNTRY

Ringette Ontario teams participating in out-of-province/country tournaments and/or exhibitions must complete Out of Provincial/Country Play Form thirty (30) days prior to the event or as soon as accepted.

These teams are approved if they complete the form and provide the host with a copy of their properly completed TRF. Any substitute players and/or bench staff must be pre-approved.

1.3 INSURANCE

Ringette Ontario teams traveling out of country only are provided with Liability Insurance.

It is strongly advised that the team secure medical and travel insurance for all players and bench staff.

The event must be sanctioned by a recognized by Ringette Canada for the liability insurance to be in effect.
