



Guidelines for University Division Play

Team Formation

- Invitational Tournaments & Dave Bennett University Cup Team Formation will follow Ringette Ontario rules including the clause that all teams must be comprised of students attending an Ontario University/College on a Full or Part Time basis.
- The team composition is to be the same as the UCC event with 85/15 ratio for mature teams.

Substitutions for Invitational Tournaments & Provincials

- Substitutions for Invitational Tournaments & Dave Bennett University Cup (Provincials) will follow Ringette Ontario rules including the clause that all substitutes must be registered in a post -secondary program and adhere to their school's policy.

Player Eligibility

- Coaches have agreed that the university division at Tournaments and Provincials will adhere to the UCC rules for team composition. The UCC Policy and Procedures Manual states that *Players registered with the National Ringette League (except affiliates) are not permitted to participate in the University Challenge Cup as players.*
- National Ringette League affiliates officially designated for the current season as one of the following:
 - 1.) Development Affiliate Player
 - 2.) Affiliate Player
 - 3.) Restricted Affiliate Playermay participate in the University Challenge Cup. However, this will only be the case if they have not participated in more than seven league, playoff or championship National Ringette League games in the preceding twelve-month period which commenced on December 1 of the previous year and ended on November 30 of the current year. Suitable documentation to confirm compliance must be submitted.

Requirements to Attend Dave Bennett University Cup

- Teams must have attended 3 Ringette Ontario tournaments/sanctioned events.
 - UCC will count as one of the 3 tournaments

Fair Ice

- Coaches will follow the D4 Fair Ice Policy for University teams at Invitational Tournaments and the Dave Bennett University Cup.
