### EASTERN CANADIAN RINGETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS

#### EASTERN CHAMPIONSHIPS

**1.1 Responsibility** Ringette Ontario takes over responsibility of the Provincial Teams going to Easterns once the Champion has been declared.

This would include, but not be limited to, coach qualifications, accommodations, travel and team communication.

**1.1** The host and dates of the Eastern Championships can be found in the Sanctioned Tournament Listing in the Events and Activities section by October 1<sup>st</sup>.

**1.2** The winner and runner up of the top tier at the "AA" Provincials from the U14 division and the winner of the 18+ AA division will represent Ontario at the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships. The winner of the top tier at the "A Provincials" in the U16A and U19A divisions will represent Ontario at the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships.

**1.3** Ringette Ontario covers the entry cost for Team Ontario U14AA, U16A, U19A and 18+AA to the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships.

**1.4** All Intent to proceed forms for the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships shall include documentation detailing all possible disciplines and fines for failure to comply.

**1.5** Any team withdrawing their intent to proceed to the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships will be responsible for the registration fee as well as a fine to Ringette Ontario that is equal to that of the original registration fee.

**1.6** In accordance with Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships Policy guidelines, alterations to the team roster after the roster deadline shall be made only in the case of injury. The team must have less than thirteen (13) skaters or only one (1) goalie. All pickups must be from the same association. Teams must contact Ringette Ontario Technical Director for all substitution inquiries.

- 1.7 A player may play on only one team at the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships
- 1.8 Champions: Ringette Ontario will book hotel accommodations for Team Ontario U14AA, U16A, U19A and 18+AA attending Easterns **which must be used.** Each team is responsible for payment of the arrangements.
- 1.9 Ringette Ontario will provide Team Ontario teams with on-ice sweaters and pants: these must be returned upon completion of Easterns. The teams representing Ontario have the right to purchase their sweaters and pants, after the Easterns, at replacement cost.
- 1.10 The team must book its flights through the official travel sponsor (if applicable) and is responsible for all costs incurred.
- 1.11 Ceremonial uniforms provided by the Ringette Ontario for the teams representing Ontario at the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships will prominently display the wording "Team Ontario". Provisions should be made so all team members and up to five (5) Bench Staff are included.
