



## COVID Safety Leader

Ringette Ontario is eager to get our Associations moving forward and preparing for the relaunch of ringette this fall.

The first step in the process is having Associations identify who will be their **COVID Safety Leader (CSL)** (Ringette Canada has identified this position as the Safety Officer).

The CSL, while not an Association board position, will be the key point of contact for your association between your facility, your Region and Ringette Ontario. Internally, they will communicate with your trainers, coaches and teams, ensuring that everyone is aware of expectations both within your local facility and Ringette Ontario.

In choosing this individual, it is strongly recommended that they have the following skills:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Be comfortable with technology: RO will be utilizing a project management and communication tool called Basecamp to keep track of Return to Activity and Return to Play guidelines and restrictions across the country. Each CSL will be required to be on this platform in order to communicate with RO, the Region and other Associations.
- Can commit to providing an update on a weekly/biweekly basis on the status of your Association/municipality on Basecamp and communicating the information from RO to Associations frequently.
- Be prepared to be in this role and be an active participant in the RO Basecamp for the 2020-21 season.
