### **Head Coach for Canada Winter Games 2023**

Ringette Ontario is seeking an enthusiastic, experienced, and self-motivated candidate who has high personal/professional ethical standards to act as Head Coach for the 2023 Canada Winter Games team.

The Head Coach will be responsible for the planning, organization, and preparation of the U20 Team Ontario Canada Winter Games (CWG) team for the 2023 CWG to be held in Prince Edward Island.

The ideal candidate will have proven track records and experience with ringette at major national competitions such as the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships, Canadian Ringette Championships, and/or past Ontario Winter Games.

The successful candidate must possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills as the Head Coach will work closely with athletes, other team staff members, families, Ringette ON Staff, event personnel, and other members of the Ringette ON high performance teams.

To be eligible for the positions, individuals must be Competition Development Certified in Ringette by July 31, 2022. In addition to achieving Competition Development Certified status, the coach must have all additional Ringette ON required coaching certification completed. Applicants must be members in good standing with Ringette Ontario.

The position requires excellent organizational abilities and a results-oriented approach to working with Ringette ON's staff, including team staff and all ringette stakeholders. Extensive evening and weekend work and travel will be required. The Head Coach is in a volunteer capacity with Ringette ON. Travel and expenses are covered by the Team Account which will be managed in conjunction with the RO staff. The terms of appointment are from January 1st, 2021 to April 30th, 2023.



## Minimum requirements to apply:

- Competition Introduction Certification
- Making Headway in Sport
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Safe Sport Training
- At least 2 years experience coaching at the AA/AAA level

All coaches must have the following Coaching Certifications completed by the Canada Winter Games deadline of July 31, 2022.

Coaching Level: **Competition Development Certified**

Professional Development:

- Make Ethical Decisions for Competition Development
- Standard First Aid Certification

## Documents for Package:

- ✓ NCCP Transcript
- ✓ Copies of any additional certifications such as first aid, Prevention in Motion, Concussion Awareness Training
- ✓ Cover letter
- ✓ Sport Resume
- ✓ Two letters of reference (One must be Letter of endorsements from a local association)
- ✓ Program Plan spanning time of appointment as the coach of the team to April 2023.  
The program plan must include:
  - Yearly Training Plan for year of the games 2022-2023
  - Budget outline for the program
- ✓ Please ensure all relevant certificates are current and included in your package. Cover letter should be no longer than one page.
- ✓ **On all documents submitted please include your NCCP #**

The Head Coach will have an active role in determining the remaining members of the Team Ontario Bench Staff and additional support Staff. The Head Coach will also work with the RO Technical Director to create the High-Performance Plan leading up to the Canada Winter Games.
