Team Staff Application

Ringette Ontario is seeking coaches and trainers to be a part of the Ringette Ontario AAA High Performance Program for the upcoming season.

The Ringette Ontario AAA HP Program focus is on development and creation of a competitive program that provides players with exposure to high level development opportunities as well as the best high-performance coaching in Ontario. The AAA HP Program allows Ringette Ontario selected Coaches, including the Team Ontario bench staff to identify and develop Ontario's most gifted young ringette players, to encourage and motivate them to play for their province and to provide them with the opportunities to measure and refine their skills at the top-level competitions. These competitions may include the Ontario Winter Games (U19) and Canada Winter Games (U20), as well as possible future opportunities within the NRL, the Junior National Team and Senior National Team Programs.

Capacity

Based on an estimated eleven (11) team program (6 teams that will compete at the Ontario Winter Games (OWG) and 5 development teams, that will attend Development Camps but not the OWG's), we currently have capacity to accept up to 50 staff totals (44 coaches and 6 trainers). If our numbers are reduced due to OWG restrictions (our athlete numbers have not been confirmed by OWG's at this time) by then we will update the number of teams and therefore, decrease the number of Team Staff that will be required.

Eligibility

Coaches must have the following qualifications to be considered:

- Competition Introduction (CI) Certification
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Making Head Way in Sport
- Safe Sport Training

Trainers must have the following qualifications:

- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders and/or Safe Sport Training
- Standard First Aid or Equivalent
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Making Head Way in Sport

Program Details

Coaches will begin in June with a series of virtual professional development opportunities and assist in preparing athletes in the program with technical/tactical and strategy sessions.

Ringette Ontario will host selection camps in early October for all athletes and program coaches to attend. Coaches and additional evaluators will be evaluating and working with the athletes to determine the top 108 athletes to be chosen as part of the OWG bound teams and up to an additional 75 athletes to be a part of the development teams.

Players will be divided into teams consisting of players from all areas of Ontario, while staffs will also be divided based on experience, roles, and gender.

Once teams are created, coaches and athletes will be introduced virtually, and coaches will have access to zoom platform to start team meetings and team bonding opportunities on a regular basis.

Ontario Winter Games – Renfrew – February 24th – 27th (for OWG teams)
